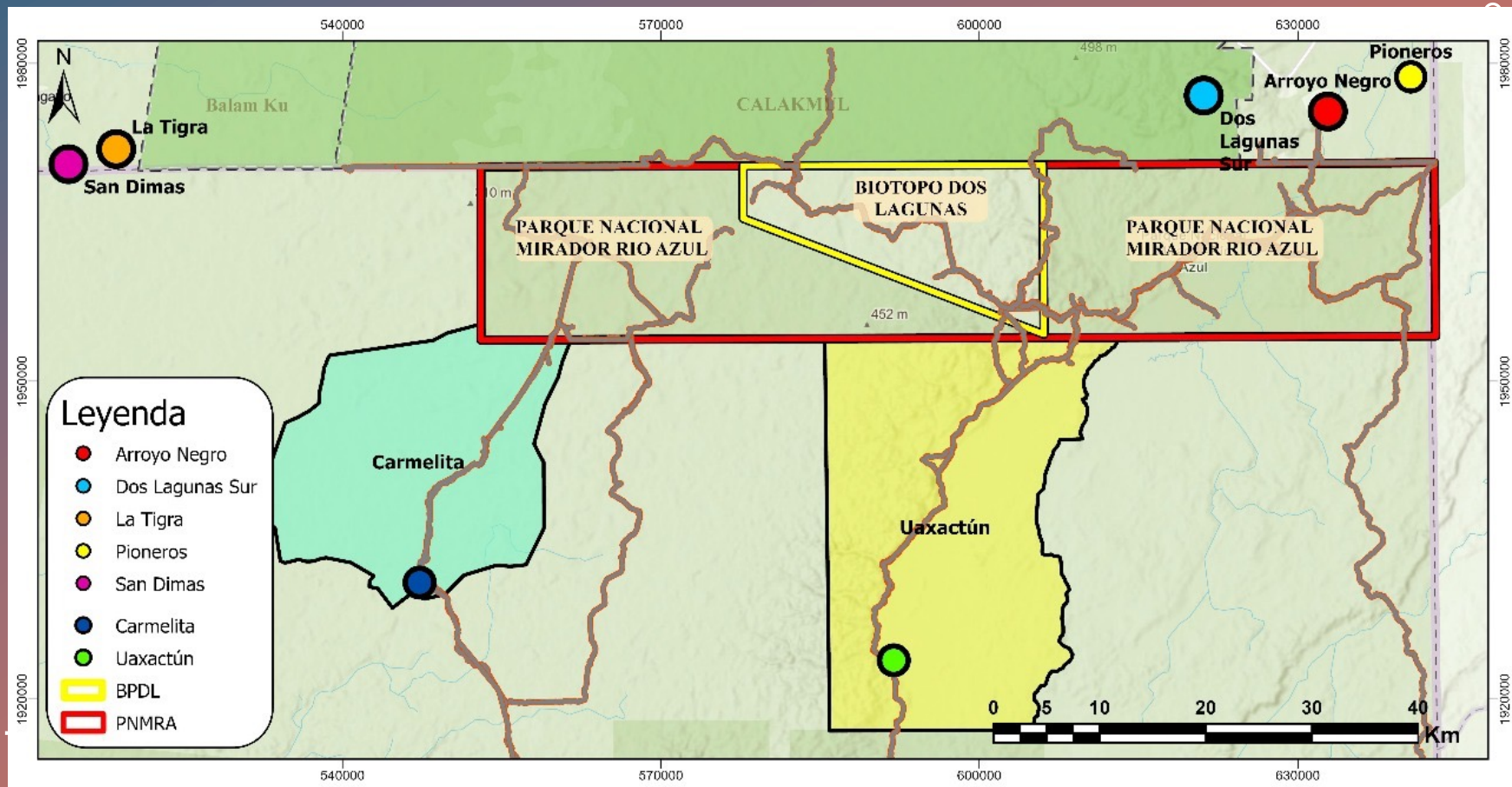

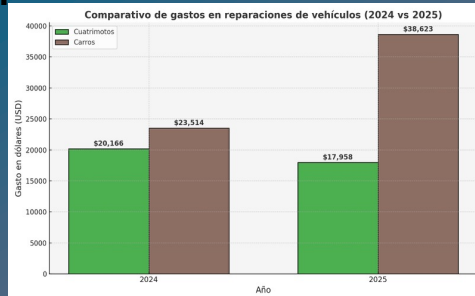


Heart of the Maya Forest

During the first nine months of the year, the park rangers covered more than 40,536 kilometers in patrols for the control and protection of the territory.



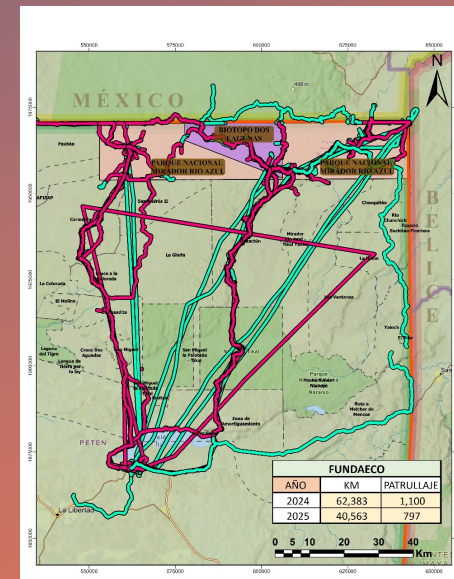

They work alongside the Army and DIPRONA, confronting threats such as illegal logging, human invasions, poaching, and wildfires.

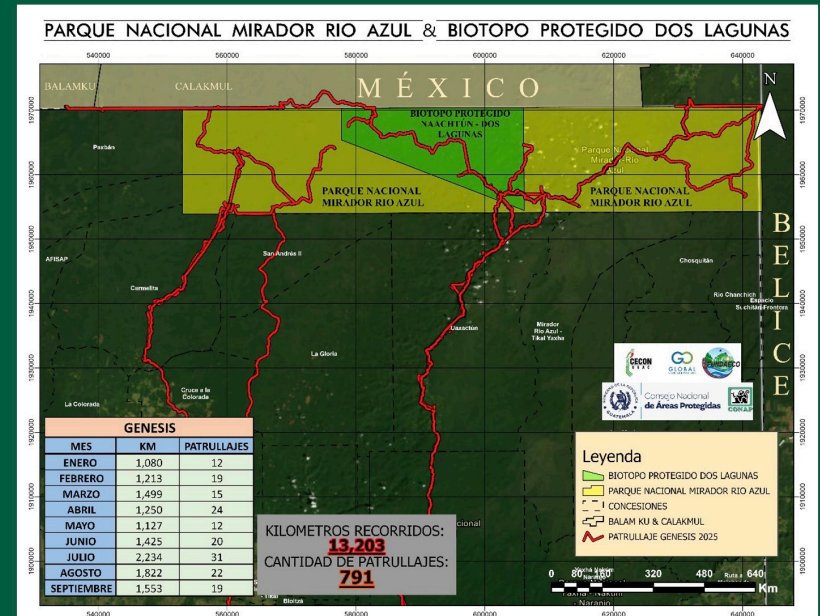
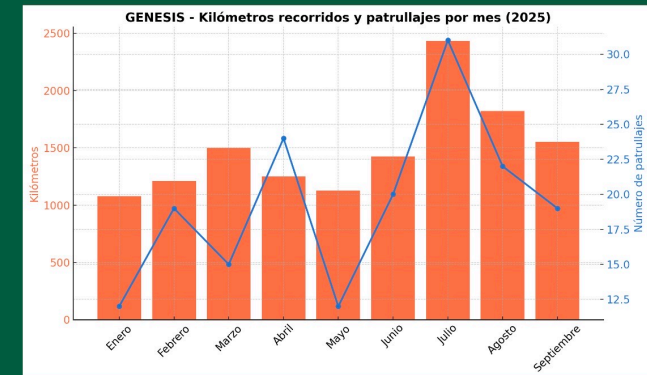

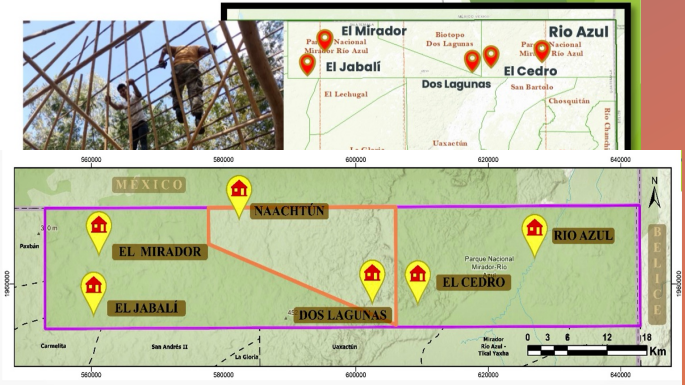




CAMPSITES - INFRASTRUCTURE

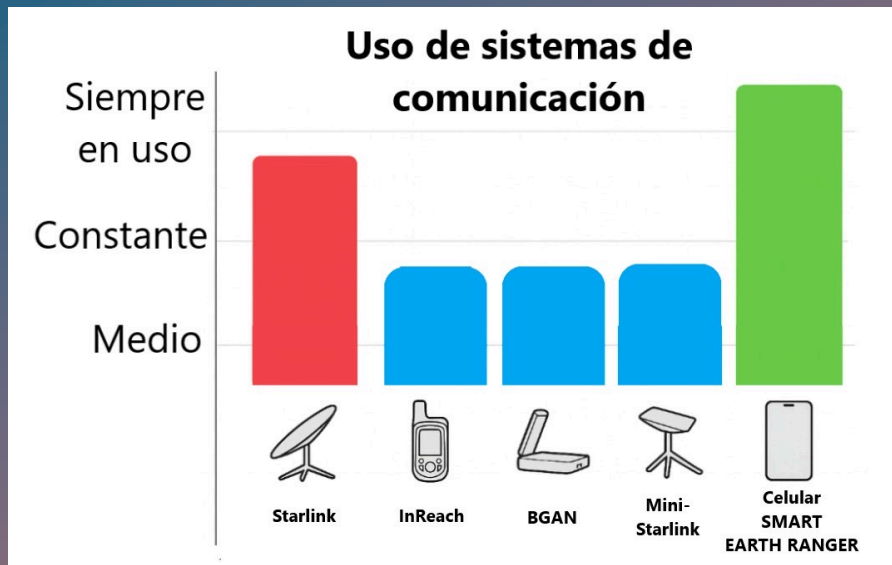
Each month, renovation or maintenance of each campsite is carried out according to the specific needs identified.

- Renovation of the kitchen in Ixcán Río
- Installation of solar panels in Cedro and Río Azul
- Construction of bathrooms in the Mirador campsite
- Towers for new Rotoplas tanks in Dos Lagunas and Cedro
- Starlink internet installed in all campsites
- Installation of signs along the Guatemala-Mexico border to strengthen area protection
- InReach communications
- Solar energy (solar panels)
- Construction of rooms in Dos Lagunas
- Construction of a deck in the Dos Lagunas bungalow

We have the best communication technology — probably the most advanced communication system of all the national parks in Guatemala.

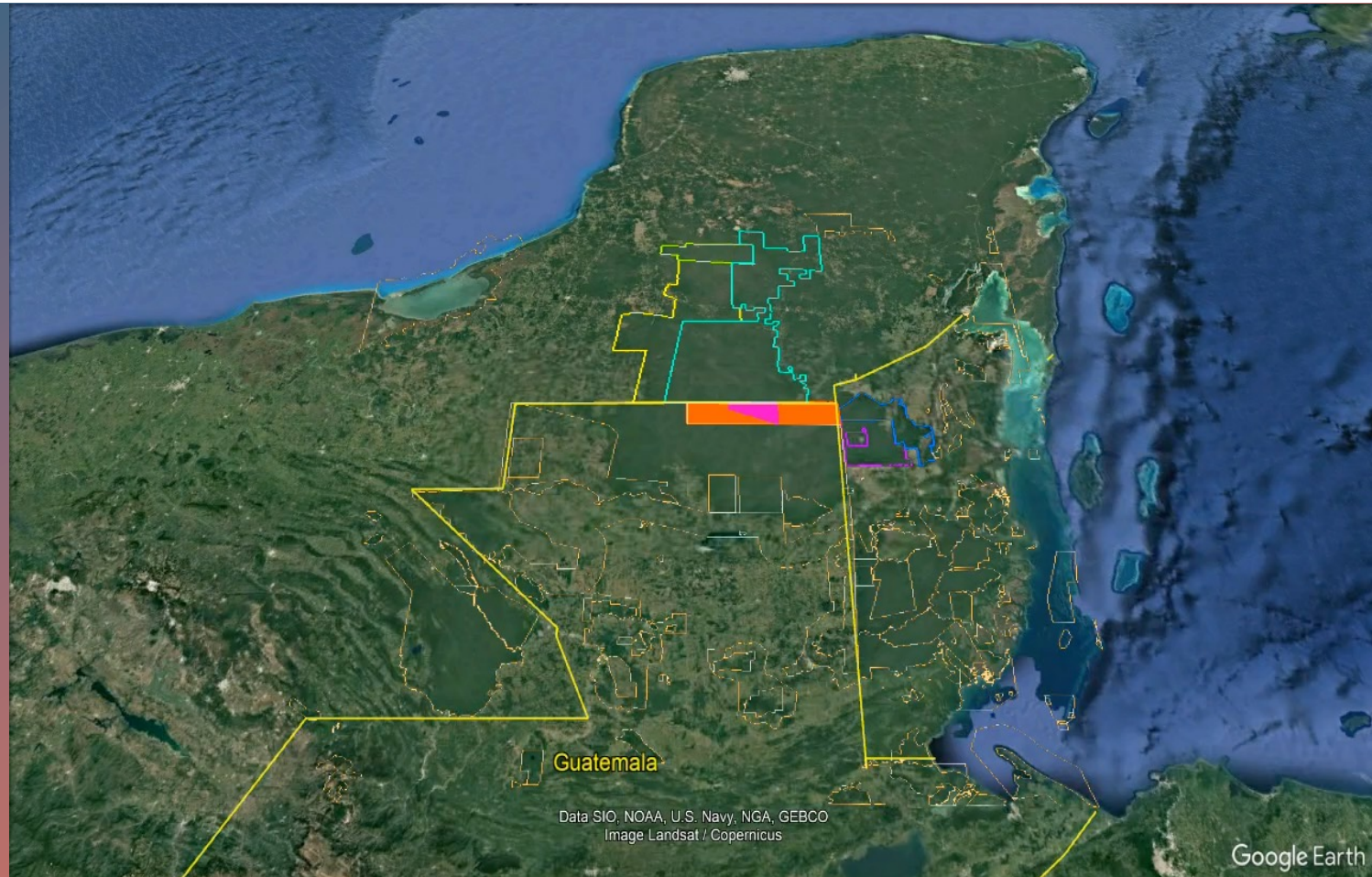
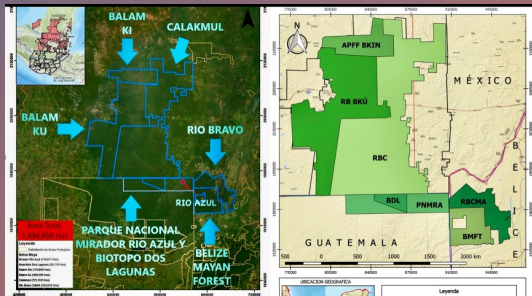

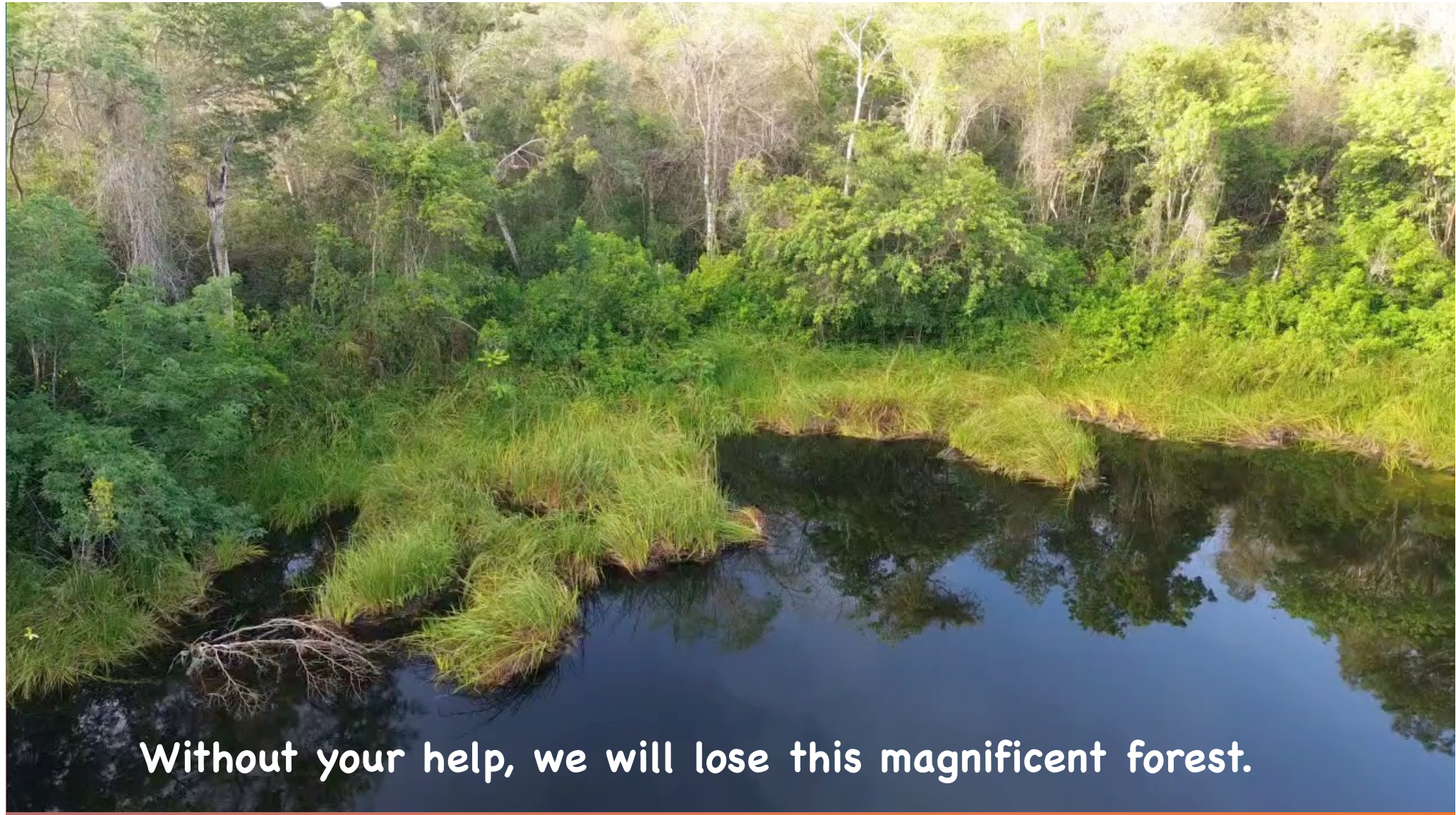




But our work has not stopped there — we have been protecting “THE HEART OF THE MAYA FOREST” for more than 15 years, together with Mexico and Belize.
