






Heart of the Maya Forest

#### **KILOMETROS** 40,536 KM

During the first nine months of the year, the park rangers covered more than 40,536 kilometers in patrols for the control and protection of the territory.

In the first nine months of the year, more than 795 patrols were carried out for the control, monitoring, and protection of the natural areas.



In 9 months, we have covered the equivalent of 1.26 laps around planet Earth.




In 2024 and 2025 combined, we have covered the equivalent of 2.6 laps around planet Earth.



We have the best communication technology — probably the most advanced communication system of all the national parks in Guatemala.








